Transport Canada has reviewed the Developer's Assessment Report (DAR) and is providing the following comments:

As previously identified in Transport Canada's letter dated March 17, 2008, the Proponent must make a current application to the Navigable Waters Protection Office, Transport Canada to determine if approval is required for the existing works and for all proposed works placed in, on, over, through or across navigable water under the *Navigable Waters Protection Act (NWPA)*, including but not limited to the construction of in-water structures and overhead transmission lines that cross navigable waterways.

The Proponent must also contact Marine Safety, Transport Canada for their approval of any shipping or barging operations and for the handling of any hazardous products i.e. fuel.
